

Euricse WP - Preparing to Submit

Before submitting a manuscript, please gather the following information:

- All Author(s)
 - First and Last Names
 - Postal Addresses
 - E-mail addresses
- Title
- Abstract
- JEL code
- Keywords

Please send manuscript files in Word or RTF format, in order to allow for the editors or referee to directly intervene on the paper with comments and for the reviser to edit the file electronically.

Preferably, the manuscript should be in 11 point Verdana type font, while, tables, table notes, and text for figures should be in 10 point Verdana, single spaced. Footnotes should be in 9 point Calibri type.

Preferably, papers submitted must be no longer than a total of 40 pages including references, figures, and tables.

We prefer that you include your figures and tables in your manuscript and submit the entire document as a Word document. If you must submit Figures/Images separately, they should be in TIFF, GIF, JPG, or PDF.

The paper must include a complete bibliography of all citations in the text (for citations in the text and bibliography please check the ***style guidelines***)

Concerning the content, please submit only papers that are in line with the Institute's philosophy, independent from their scientific approach (the Series will include economic, legal, managerial, historical, and sociological papers). Topics of particular interest include:

- Empirical analyses of cooperatives in any sector (Co-operatives Banks, Consume cooperatives, Agricultural co-operatives, Production co-operatives, Workers co-operatives, Social co-operatives, etc.)
- Analyses of the evolution and the history of cooperatives, social enterprises or nonprofit organizations
- Descriptive analysis of rationale, role, behaviour, and impact of cooperatives or social enterprises
- Nonprofit organizations
- Social capital
- Social economy
- Social policies
- Comparisons among organizational types
- Comparisons within countries and sectors of activity
