

## **REGULATIONS FOR ASSOCIATE MEMBERS**

These regulations have been drawn up pursuant to article 3 of the Charter of the Foundation and establish the conditions and modalities for Associate Membership.

### **Article1 – ADMISSION**

Private and public bodies as well as those without legal charter who, sharing the aims and objectives indicated in article 2 of the Charter, apply to the Management Committee can be admitted as Associate Members. The Management Committee will admit them with a deliberation pursuant to article 10 of the Charter. After admission, Associate Membership can be renewed annually by the payment, within the first trimester, of the contribution set annually by the committee.

### **Article 2 – MEMBERSHIP CONDITIONS**

Associate members pledge to contribute to the activities of the Foundation as indicated in article 3 of the Charter, with a minimum annual contribution of €200, to be paid into the current account of the Foundation within one month of application acceptance and, in the case of membership renewal, by March 31<sup>st</sup> of each year. Associate Members have the right to participate in the meetings of the Steering Committee as non-voting members and to be informed about the activities of the Foundation through consultation of the multi-year plans and activities and the annual reports on the activities undertaken, which will be made available on the Foundation's website. Associate Members can also participate in the activities organised by the Foundation.
